The information we collect is used to improve the content of our Web page, used to customize the content and or layout of our page for each individual visitor, used to notify consumers about updates to our Web site, and in general to keep us informed of the preferences of our audience and customers.

With respect to cookies

Cookies are pieces of text that may be provided to your computer through your web browser when you access a website. Your browser stores cookies in a manner associated with each website you visit. With respect to email

We collect the e-mail addresses of those who post messages of those who communicate with us via e-mail, the e-mail addresses of those who make postings to our chat/Slack areas, aggregate information on what pages consumers access or visit, user-specific information on what pages consumers access or visit, information volunteered by the consumer, such as survey information and/or site registrations.

For each visitor to our Web page, our Web server automatically recognizes only the consumer's domain name, but not the e-mail address (where possible).
